1. The present application has been filed on behalf of the petitioner, *inter-alia* seeking prayer for impleading the Bombay Stock Exchange ("BSE") as one of the parties, in the present proceedings.
2. Mr. Prakash Choradia, Authorized Representative of the respondent-company submits that he has no objection if the BSE is made a party herein.
3. Accordingly, considering the submissions made before this Court, and



with the consent of the parties, the BSE is impleaded as respondent no. 9 in the present petition.

4. With the aforesaid directions, the present application is accordingly disposed of.

5. In view of the directions passed in *CM APPL. 51349/2026*, let amended Memo of Parties be filed by the petitioner, within a period of one week, from today.

6. Accordingly, issue notice to the newly impleaded respondent-BSE, upon filing of the Process Fee, returnable on the next date of hearing.

7. The Authorized Representative of the respondent-company submits that the main counsel is not available, and thus, seeks an accommodation for today.

8. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner draws the attention of this Court to the order dated 24th March, 2026, wherein, it had been noted that the respondent-company has assured and undertaken that the petitioner's name shall be removed from the list of promoters on the website of the BSE, latest within a period of four weeks.

9. It is submitted that the same has not been done.

10. In response, the Authorized Representative for the respondent-company submits that they had filed an application before the BSE for deletion of the name of the petitioner from the list of their promoters. However, he submits that the said application has been rejected by the BSE.

11. Accordingly, let Compliance Affidavit be filed by the respondents, in terms of the order dated 24th March, 2026, before the next date of hearing.
