I.A. 22103/2025 (For exemption)

1. Exemption allowed, subject to all just exceptions.
2. The application stands disposed of.

I.A. 22105/2025 (exemption from filing ad-volerm Court fees in the presnt suit under Section 151 of CPC)

1. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the plaintiffs submits that the plaintiffs are in constructive possession of the property; and therefore, they are not liable to pay the *ad-volerm* court fees. He, therefore, seeks liberty to withdraw the instant application.
2. Liberty, so prayed for, is granted.
3. The instant application stands dismissed as withdrawn.
4. All rights and contentions of the defendants stand reserved.

I.A. 22106/2025 (Extension of time from filing Court fees)

1. Since, the application bearing I.A.22105/2025 is allowed to be withdrawn, therefore, the instant application has rendered infructuous.



2. The instant application stands disposed of as rendered infructuous.

CS(OS) 618/2025 and I.A. 22104/2025

1. The plaint be registered as a suit. Summons of the suit and the notice of the accompanying application bearing I.A. 22104/2025 be issued to the defendants by all permissible modes on filing of process fee. Affidavit of service be filed within two weeks.

2. The summons shall indicate that the written statements must be filed within thirty days from the date of receipt of the summons. The defendants shall also file affidavits of admission/denial of the documents filed by the plaintiff, failing which the written statements shall not be taken on record.

3. The plaintiffs are at liberty to file replications thereto within thirty days after filing of the written statements. The replications shall be accompanied by affidavits of admission/denial in respect of the documents filed by the defendants, failing which the replications shall not be taken on record.

4. It is made clear that any unjustified denial of documents may lead to an order of costs against the concerned party.

5. Any party seeking inspection of documents may do so in accordance with the Delhi High Court (Original Side) Rules, 2018.

6. List before the concerned Joint Registrar for taking up necessary further steps in accordance with extant rules on 25.11.2025.

7. Once the pleadings in application bearing I.A. 22104/2025 are complete, let the matter be listed before the Court on the date to be fixed by the concerned Joint Registrar.
