1. Allowed, subject to all just exceptions.
2. The application stands disposed of.

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3. By virtue of the present petition, the petitioner seeks transfer of the divorce petition bearing HMA No.2258/2025 tilted as “**Satish Kumar Aggarwal vs Akansha**” pending before learned Additional Principal Judge Family Court, South West District, Dwarka Courts, Delhi (**divorce petition**) to learned Family Court, North West District, Rohini Courts, Delhi.

4. It is the case of the petitioner that, though as many as two proceedings being a maintenance case bearing Mt. Case No.257/2025 and a proceeding under *Section 12* of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act 2005 bearing Ct Case No.7066/2025 are presently



pending before the Rohini Courts, the respondent has filed a divorce petition under *Section 13(1)(ia)* of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 bearing HMA No.2258/2025 before the Dwarka Courts, New Delhi as also since the petitioner is residing with her old parents with minimal assistance and is facing extreme hardships as she has to take care of the minor child as well. It is under such circumstances, the petitioner is seeking transfer of the divorce petition filed by the respondent before the Rohini Courts, Delhi.

5. Upon the petitioner taking requisite steps within a period of *one week*, issue notice to the respondent by all permissible modes, returnable on 18.12.2025.

6. Reply, if any, be filed by the respondent within a period of *four weeks*. Rejoinder thereto, if any, be filed within a period of *two weeks* thereafter.

7. Accordingly, renotify on 18.12.2025.
