1. The present petition has been filed by petitioner seeking following reliefs:

“(a) quash the decision taken by the Respondent No.2 in its 425th meeting held on 29th 30th May, 2025, whereby, the Respondent No.2, has inter-alia, decided to withdraw the recognition of Petitioner Institution in respect of its B.Ed. course; completely on the erroneous presumptions/premises; and

(b) direct the Respondent No.2 to issue restoration of recognition order, thereby restoring the Petitioner's Recognition so as to enable the Petitioner Institution to enjoy the status of being a Recognised Institution with all the consequential benefits; in respect of its B.Ed. course”
