1. Learned counsel for the respondents submit that another writ petition [W.P.(C) 1931/2021] filed by the petitioner – Delhi Prosecutors Welfare Association [“the Association”], was pending before the Division Bench, but has been withdrawn on 27.01.2025, with liberty to file a fresh petition in view of the enactment of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 [“BNSS”]. According to her, the present petition has also been rendered infructuous after the enactment of BNSS.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, however, submits that both the petitions were for entirely different reliefs. W.P.(C) 1931/2021 concerns the terms and conditions of service of the members of the Association, whereas the present writ petition is concerned with remuneration for the period from 1996 to 2004.



3. The petitioner is directed to place on record a copy of the record in W.P.(C) 1931/2021, so that the Court can examine this contention in its proper perspective.
