This petition has been filed, challenging the Order dated 29.05.2025 passed by the learned Central Administrative Tribunal, Principal Bench, New Delhi (hereinafter referred to as the 'Tribunal') in O.A. No.2351/2017, titled ***Dinesh Kumar Sharma & Ors. v. Union of India & Ors.***, whereby the O.A. filed by the petitioners herein has



been dismissed.

5. The learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the learned Tribunal has failed to appreciate that in terms of the Recruitment Rules, the candidates who are successful in the Limited Departmental Competitive Examination, are to be accommodated even against the future vacancies.

6. Issue notice.

8. The learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the remaining respondents were co-applicants with the petitioners before the learned Tribunal and, therefore, have been impleaded only as proforma parties. She submits that the notice of this petition need not be served on them.

9. We accept the above submission and dispense with service of notice of this petition on the remaining respondents.

10. Let a counter-affidavit be filed within a period of five weeks from today. Rejoinder thereto, if any, be filed within a period of two weeks thereafter.
