1. By this application, the respondent has sought constitution of a review DPC to consider his case for promotion to the Senior Scale (GNCTDSS) (Central Civil) Post, Ministerial subject to the outcome of the writ petition.

2. The petitioner has placed on record an affidavit by way of response to the application in which it is pointed out that the case of the respondent had in fact been considered by the DPC which met on



12 June 2026 but that the recommendations of the DPC were placed in a sealed cover.

3. Inasmuch as the charge sheet against the respondent was quashed by the Tribunal, and no order of stay was passed by this Court, the case of the respondent ought not to have been relegated to sealed cover.

4. Ms. Ahlawat submits that the sealed cover has since been opened but that the respondent could not be promoted for the reason set out in the additional affidavit.

5. Though learned Counsel for the respondent sought to contest the correctness of the decision not to promote the respondent, that, to our mind, would constitute a fresh cause of action which cannot be considered in this application.

6. Inasmuch as the sealed cover has been opened and the recommendations of the DPC, as contained in the sealed cover, have been acted upon, no further orders are required to be passed in this application, which is disposed of.
