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1. I.A No. 19849/2023 for *amendment* in the plaint has been disposed off but has been shown pending in the e-record. Registry is directed to take necessary steps in this regard.
2. Defendant no. 2 was impleaded vide order dated 11.12.2025 on which date plaint was also amended. Ld. Counsel who was appearing for the sole defendant i.e. now defendant no. 1, is also appearing for defendant no. 2.
