1. Exemption allowed, subject to all just exceptions.
2. The application stands disposed of.

3. The petitioner has challenged the order dated 24.03.2018, pursuant to which the summons were issued in a complaint filed by the respondent under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881.

4. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is not authorized signatory of the cheque in dispute and only a vague allegation has been made in the complaint that the petitioner being the Director, Incharge of managing day to day affairs is liable for the issuance of the cheque.

5. He submits that the complainant has simply taken out data from the website and has made all the persons holding the managerial post as the accused.



6. He further submits that two of the accused persons who are similarly placed have also challenged the impugned order, which is pending consideration before this Court in CRL. M.C. 4497/2019 and CRL. M.C. 2520/2020. He submits that the arguments have already been heard in those petitions and judgment is reserved.
7. He further submits that the petitioner has now challenged the impugned order since the trial has not proceeded and even notice is yet to be framed.
8. Issue notice.
9. Notice be served through all permissible modes.
10. The petitioner is exempted from personal appearance before the learned Trial Court till the next date of hearing.
