1. Allowed, subject to all just exceptions.
2. The application stands disposed of.

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3. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner, a minor (2 year old) represented through her mother, seeking the following prayers:

“a. Issue a writ of mandamus directing the Respondent Authorities to arrange and provide for the proper medical care and treatment of the Petitioner till her full recovery; and

b. Direct the Respondents to immediately admit the Petitioner in AIIMS, New Delhi / or Safdarjung Hospital, New Delhi for her treatment and diagnosis;”

4. Learned counsel on behalf of the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been facing difficulty in securing admission at hospitals despite the petitioner being in urgent/dire need of immediate medical treatment. It is submitted that the petitioner has been diagnosed with a serious health



condition and has been advised immediate hospitalization by a pediatrician.

5. It is submitted that the petitioner's mother lacks financial resources, and has faced considerable hardship in arranging medical care, particularly in view of the fact that the petitioner's father is presently in judicial custody.

6. Issue notice.

7. Learned counsel, as aforesaid, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent nos.1 and 2.

8. Issue notice to the respondent nos.3 and 4, through all permissible modes including electronically, returnable for the next date of hearing.

9. Considering the urgency in the aforesaid circumstances, the Medical Superintendent of the Safdarjung Hospital, Delhi is directed to ensure that the petitioner is admitted and accorded appropriate medical treatment.

10. It is made clear that the above directions have been issued on account of the peculiar circumstances of the case.
