1. Learned counsel for petitioner submits that respondent had filed *Special Leave Petition* (SLP) and such SLP i.e. SLP (C) diary No. 55682/2024 has already been dismissed on 02.01.2025.
2. Such fact is not disputed by learned counsel for respondent.
3. Learned counsel for respondent prays for a short adjournment to place on record a compliance affidavit.
4. It is noticed that the Original Application (OA) was filed by petitioner way back in the year 2013 and such OA was decided on 24.12.2014.
5. Thereafter, the writ petition filed by respondent was dismissed on 02.02.2024.
6. Such order has already attained finality.
7. As per final decision, while setting aside the impugned order dated 04.12.2012 and while declaring APAR of the petitioner for the period 01.04.2009 to 28.02.2010 as *non est*, there is a direction to respondent to consider the consequential benefits.
8. Needless to say, the consequential benefit would also include considering her for promotion.
9. Learned counsel for petitioner submits that the petitioner is due to retire next

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year and the intent and objective of the respondent is to frustrate her rights by not even considering such consequential benefits despite there being categoric orders to the above said effect and also despite the fact that the above said order has attained finality.

11. Let the compliance affidavit be filed by respondent and a clear timeline in such affidavit be also specified as to when the case of the petitioner would be considered by the concerned Committee for her further promotion etc.

12. In case, no such affidavit is filed, both the contemnor shall also appear in person on the next date of hearing.
