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1. Pursuant to the last order, learned counsel for the parties have obtained instructions.

01.04.2018. Learned counsel for the appellant/wife in MAT.APP.(F.C.) 79/2019, however, submits that this suggestion is not acceptable to the appellant. In the light of this stand taken by the parties, the matter will be required to be heard on merits.

3. At this stage, learned counsel for the parties jointly submit that the matter be referred to the Delhi High Court Mediation and Conciliation Centre (hereinafter “the Mediation Centre”) to enable the parties explore the possibility of an amicable settlement.
4. At the joint request of learned counsel for the parties, the matter is referred to the Mediation Centre.
5. List before the Mediation Centre on 03.02.2025 on which date, the parties/ their authorised representatives will appear before the Mediation Centre either physically or virtually.
6. List before the Court on 05.05.2025.
