1. The petition is for the following reliefs:

*“(a) Pass necessary orders and directions thereby quashing the FIR No.0413/2025 dated 02.06.2025, under section 25 of Arms Act, 1959, P.S. IGI Airport, New Delhi and proceedings emanating there-from.”*

2. The paragraph no.3 of the status report filed by respondent-State is extracted as under:

*“3. Request for Arms Licence verification of arms licence bearing No. 74/JTCP/GGM/2018 has been sent to Joint Commissioner of Police, Arms Licence Branch, Gurugram, Haryana has been sent vide letter No. 4470/SO/ADDL.CP/(DA-IIYIGI Airport dated 05.08.2025. Verified report has been received and placed on file. It states that the License no. 74/JTCP/GGM/2018 is issued to Mr. Manoj Sharma s/o B.G Sharma and valid upto 25-07-26.”*

3. It, thus, appear that the verification of the arms license has been done



and the same belongs to the petitioner.

4. In view of the verification of the arms license of the petitioner, the offence in question is not made out, and, accordingly, the FIR No. 0413/2025 dated 02.06.2025, under section 25 of Arms Act, 1959, registered at P.S. IGI Airport, New Delhi, and all consequential action pursuant thereto stands quashed.

5. The petition stands disposed of.
