I.A. 24048/2025 (seeking exemption from filing original/certified copies etc.)

1. Allowed, subject to the plaintiffs filing legible copies of documents within four (4) weeks from today.
2. The plaintiffs are exempted from filing originals at this stage.
3. The application stands disposed of.

CS(COMM) 1018/2025

4. Earlier, the plaintiffs have filed a Civil Suit being CS(COMM) 73/2024, which was withdrawn with a liberty to file a fresh suit.



5. Hence, the present suit has been filed.
6. Let the plaint be registered as a suit.
7. Issue summons.
8. Summons are accepted by counsel appearing on behalf of the defendant no.2 and waives issuance of formal summons.
- 8.1. Written statement shall be filed on behalf of the defendant no.2 within thirty (30) days from today.
9. Summons be issued to the defendant no.1 through all modes. The summons shall state that the written statement shall be filed by the defendant no.1 within thirty (30) days from the date of the receipt of summons. Along with the written statement(s), the defendants shall also file affidavit of admission/denial of the documents of the plaintiffs, without which the written statement(s) shall not be taken on record.
10. Liberty is given to the plaintiffs to file replication(s), if any, within thirty (30) days from the receipt of the written statement(s). Along with the replication(s) filed by the plaintiffs, affidavit of admission/denial of the documents of the defendants be filed by the plaintiffs.
11. The parties shall file all original documents in support of their respective claims along with their respective pleadings. In case parties are placing reliance on a document, which is not in their power and possession, its detail and source shall be mentioned in the list of reliance, which shall also be filed with the pleadings.
12. If any of the parties wish to seek inspection of any documents, the same shall be sought and given within the timelines.
13. List before the Joint Registrar on 19th November, 2025 for completion of service and pleadings.



14. List before the Court on 20th February, 2026.
