% **ORDER**

By way of the present petition filed under section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita 2023, the petitioner impugns summoning order dated 18.12.2023, whereby the learned Metropolitan Magistrate, Tis Hazari Courts, Delhi has been pleased to take cognisance of the offences under sections 182/192/211 of the Indian Penal Code 1860, after declining to accept the closure report filed by the Investigating Officer; and has been pleased to issue summons to the petitioner. The petitioner is stated to be the former daughter-in-law of respondent No.2/complainant.

2. Ms. Pallavi Singh, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits, that the allegations which are the basis of the summoning order are belied by the medical documents and prescriptions on record, authenticity of which has been confirmed by the attending doctor.
3. It is noticed however that the second page of the summoning order has not been placed on record.



4. In the circumstances, Ms. Singh seeks time to place on record a complete copy of the summoning order as well as certain other documents, which would support her contention.
5. Let the needful be done before the next date.
6. The next date before the learned Trial Court is stated to be 27.01.2025.
7. Re-notify for consideration on 10th January 2025.
