ORDER

1. The present petition arises out of a matrimonial dispute.

4. In the backdrop of above development, the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the parties jointly submit that there is a possibility of amicable



resolution to the dispute in case the parties are referred to mediation.

5. In view of the above, the parties are referred to mediation under the aegis of Delhi High Court Mediation and Conciliation Centre.

6. The parties are directed to appear before the Centre on 20.01.2025 at 03.00 P.M.

7. List before Court for reporting of settlement, if any, on 29.04.2025.

8. Since the parties have been referred to mediation, the learned Trial Court is requested to defer the proceedings to a date after the next date fixed before this Court.
