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1. This hearing has been done through hybrid mode.
2. The present appeal under Section 96 of the CPC seeks the following prayers: -

“It is, therefore, most respectfully prayed that the appeal of the appellant may please be accepted, set aside the impugned judgment and decree of the trial Court dated 10.09.2009 passed in Civil Suit No. 238/2005 by the Ld. Court of Sh. Sanjeev Jain, ADJ, Delhi and allow/decreed the suit, of the appellant/plaintiff as prayed for, in the interest of justice.”
