1. The present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (formerly Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973) seeks directions to Respondent No. 1 to provide protection to the Petitioners.
2. Counsel for the Petitioners assert that the parties have married each other and are facing threats from their parents. He places reliance on a marriage certificate annexed with the petition. Nonetheless, before issuing any directions, the Court deems it appropriate to direct the presence of the Petitioners before the Court.
3. In the meantime, the State is directed to verify the certificates enclosed with the petition. As the Petitioners apprehend threats, the concerned SHO is directed to provide protection if the need arises. For this purpose, the Petitioners' counsel is instructed to intimate the residential



address to the concerned Investigating Officer whenever the Petitioners visit Delhi.
