ORDER

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1. The father and wife of the victim are present and they submit that the settlement terms offered by the Petitioner are acceptable to them. The settlement terms proposes employment for the brother of the deceased, including one year training period with salary of INR 19,000/- per month. In addition to the above, they have offered an amount of INR 5,00,000/- to be paid to the wife of the deceased.
2. While the father and wife of the victim has agreed to the aforesaid terms, the State opposes the settlement, submitting that the deceased was 30 years old at the time of the incident and, in terms of the Employees' Compensation Act, 1993, the compensation payable, based on the salary of the deceased, works out to approximately INR 19.2 lakhs. In light of the



same, the Court has asked the Petitioner to consider enhancement of the settlement amount. Mr. Nishant Kumar, present in person, seeks a short accommodation to obtain instructions.

3. Re-notify on 18th December, 2025.
4. On the next date of hearing, family members of the victim may join the proceedings through video conferencing mechanism.
