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1. In the present petition, this Court had passed a detailed order dated 05th February, 2026 clarifying that the prayer for quashing would be considered only if the parties were agreeable to the terms stipulated therein, the requisite undertakings were filed, and proof of compliance was placed on record.

2. Admittedly, no such undertaking has been filed. Mr. Kartikay Kaushik, counsel for the Petitioner, now submits, on instructions, that the Petitioner does not wish to pursue the present petition and seeks leave to withdraw the same.

3. The petition is, accordingly, dismissed as withdrawn.

4. It is clarified that this Court has not expressed any opinion on the merits of the case. All rights and contentions of the parties are left open. The observations contained in the order dated 05th February, 2026 were recorded



solely with a view to exploring whether the dispute could be brought to an end on the basis of the compromise proposed between the parties, subject to the conditions stipulated therein. Since the said conditions were neither accepted nor the requisite undertakings furnished, none of the observations contained in the said order shall be construed as an expression on the merits of the case or prejudice the rights and contentions of either party in any future proceedings.
