1. These are applications filed under Section 151 of CPC, 1908 on behalf of the respective petitioners seeking the following prayers:-

CM APPL. 12299/2026

“a) Clarify the Final Order dated 04.02.2026 passed by this Hon’ble Court migrating the Petitioners to GIPMER/ GB Pant Hospital by including a specific direction for the creation of supernumerary seat(s) for the Petitioner(s) in the 2024-2027 batch in the M.Ch Neurosurgery program at Govind Ballabh Pant Institute of Post Graduate Institute of Medical Education and Research (GIPMER)/ G.B. Pant Hospital;

b) Direct Respondent Nos. 4 (GNCTD), 5 (NMC) and/or 7 (Delhi University) to expeditiously, and in a time-bound manner, pass appropriate directions to grant full and complete academic, administrative and financial control of the M.Ch Neurosurgery program with respect to the Petitioners to Govind Ballabh Pant Institute of Post Graduate Institute of Medical Education and Research (GIPMER)/ G.B. Pant Hospital giving effect, in letter and



spirit, to the directions passed by this Hon'ble Court in the captioned Writ Petition;..."

"a) Clarify the Final Order dated 04.02.2026 passed by this Hon'ble Court migrating the Petitioners to GIPMER/ GB Pant Hospital by including a specific direction for the creation of supernumerary seats for the Petitioners in the 2024-2027 batch in the D.M. Neuroanaesthesia program at Govind Ballabh Pant Institute of Post Graduate Institute of Medical Education and Research (GIPMER)/ G.B. Pant Hospital;

b) Direct Respondent Nos. 4 (GNCTD), 5 (NMC) and/or 7 (Delhi University) to expeditiously, and in a time-bound manner, pass appropriate directions to grant full and complete academic, administrative and financial control of the D.M. Neuroanaesthesia program with respect to the Petitioners to Govind Ballabh Pant Institute of Post Graduate Institute of Medical Education and Research (GIPMER)/ G.B. Pant Hospital giving effect, in letter and spirit, to the directions passed by this Hon'ble Court in the captioned 'Writ Petition;..."

2. Mr. Rajvanshi, learned counsel for the petitioners, states that though the Dr. Garima Tyagi is working at Ram Manohar Lohia Hospital and Dr. Mahak Goel, Dr. Gunjan Wadhwa and Dr. Bhari Jain are working at GB Pant Hospital, they continue to be under financial and administrative control of Lok Nayak Hospital.

3. Mr. Gupta, learned counsel appearing for respondent Nos. 1 to 4 and Mr. Singhdev, learned counsel appearing for respondent No. 5, has handed



over certain communications, wherein two supernumerary seats in DM Neuro-Anaesthesia course for batch 2024-27 have been created at GB Pant Institute of Post Graduate Medical Education and Research and one seat each in M.Ch. Neurosurgery at Atal Bihari Vajpayee Institute of Medical Sciences and GB Pant Hospital.

4. In this view of the matter all the four petitioners have been accommodated.

5. Hence, the petitioners shall now be under financial and administrative control of Atal Bihari Vajpayee Institute of Medical Sciences and/or GB Pant Hospital, as the case may be.

6. I am also informed that Dr. Garima Tyagi for about a month and a half had provided services at GB Pant Hospital. All unpaid stipends due to her from the date of joining shall be cleared expeditiously and within two weeks from today, subject to verification.

7. The present applications are disposed of in aforesaid terms.

8. The documents handed over in the Court today are taken on record.
