**CCP(O) 12/2024 (Application under Section 11 and 12 of the Contempt of
Courts Act 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India)**

1. Pursuant to previous order of this Court dated 30th January 2024, Mr. Narayan Singh, Director of defendant no.1 company and Ms. Payal, Marketing Executive are present through video conferencing. Mr. Narayan Singh states that he is the Director and Founder of defendant no.1 company and on the day of execution of Local Commission, he was out of Mumbai; therefore, he had instructed Ms. Payal to attend to the situation.
2. He states that only in two low configuration machines, which had been procured from third party vendors, infringing software was found. He further states that Ms. Payal had some personal difficulty since her father was in the hospital, and therefore, she had to leave at around 5:00 p.m. Resultantly, the Local Commission could not be concluded; otherwise, they had no intention to obstruct execution of the Commission in any manner whatsoever.



3. Counsel for plaintiff states that the same was found in 4 out of 15 machines which were inspected.
4. Detailed facts of the same and reply to this application to be filed by counsel for defendants within a period of 6 weeks from today with a copy to the opposing counsel.
5. Renotify on 9th August 2024.
6. Presence of defendant nos. 1 and 2 is discharged for the time being.
7. Order be uploaded on the website of this Court.
