Criminal Leave Petition under Sections 378(4) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 ('Cr.P.C.') has been preferred on behalf of the petitioner for setting aside judgment dated 22.12.2022 and order on sentence dated 23.12.2022 passed by learned Special Judge, (PC Act) CBI-14, Rouse Avenue District Courts, New Delhi, whereby accused no. 3, 4 & 9 before learned Trial Court, namely, Amar Nath, Sohan Pal Sharma and Neeraj Chopra were acquitted.
