3. By virtue of the present petition, the petitioner seeks transfer of CS SCJ 846 of 2025 entitled *Santosh Kumari Gupta v Veenu Gupta* pending before the Ld. Senior Civil Judge cum RC, Central, Tis Hazari Court, New Delhi, to Ld. Senior Civil Judge, Dwarka, New Delhi.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioner primarily submits that the petitioner, who has a minor child of around 11 months, has filed a complaint dated 04.07.2025 against respondents at CAW Cell, Dabri, Dwarka, New Delhi and has also preferred a petition dated 23.07.2025 under *Section 144*, BNSS for seeking maintenance for herself and her



minor child, which is also pending before the learned Principal Judge, Family Court, South West, Dwarka, New Delhi, however, her mother in law has filed the afore-mentioned suit before another jurisdiction. This, as per learned counsel for petitioner is causing immense physical, mental and financial hardship to the petitioner.

5. It is because of the above that she has filed the present petition seeking transfer thereof.

6. Issue notice.

7. Learned counsel appearing for the respondents through Video Conferencing accepts notice. He submits that the afore-mentioned suit, of which the petitioner is seeking transfer, has been instituted by the respondent no.1/ mother-in-law of the petitioner, who is herself a senior citizen suffering from various ailments. He further submits that the same has only been instituted for protection of her own individual rights for seeking appropriate prayers against the petitioner/ wife and her son, the respondent no.2/ husband for preventing them to enter the premises bearing number N-42D, Kamla Nagar, Delhi-110007.

8. Learned counsel for respondent seeks and is granted a period of *four weeks* to file reply. Rejoinder thereto, if any, be filed within a period of *two weeks* thereafter.
