ORDER

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Proceedings are being conducted through hybrid mode.

1. Written statement filed on behalf of defendant nos. 1 & 2 vide diary no. 8124078/2025 is still lying under objections.
2. Ld. Counsel for defendant nos. 1 & 2 request for adjournment to take appropriate steps. Opposed by Ld. Counsel for plaintiff on the ground that outer limit of 120 days for filing written statement had already lapsed. Defendant nos. 1 & 2 have failed to take steps within 30 days to cure the defects for filing written statement.
3. Chapter VII Rule 4 of Delhi High Court (OS) Rules, 2018 provides that delay in filing written statement cannot be condoned beyond 120 days from the date of service.
4. Chapter IV Rule 30 of Delhi High Court (OS) Rules



provides that the objections in filing of the proceedings has to be removed within seven days at a time and 30 days in aggregate.

5. In this case defendant nos. 1 & 2 accepts the summons through their counsel on 08.10.2025. They filed written statement vide diary no. 8124078/2025 dated 12.11.2025 which is still lying under objections despite expiry of more than 4 months. The outer limit of 120 days to file written statement and the limit of 30 days to remove the objections in filing the written statement have already lapsed.
6. In these circumstances, the right of defendant nos. 1 & 2 to file written statement stands closed.
7. The right to defendant nos. 3 to 6 to file written statement and affidavit for admission/denial of documents has already been closed.
8. Pleadings are complete.
9. Re-notify the present matter before the Hon'ble Court on the date already fixed i.e. **28th May, 2026**.
