CRL.REV.P.(MAT.) 449/2025

1. This is a revision petition, impugning the order dated 14.08.2025, passed by the learned Family Court in MT case No. 278/2020, titled as, "*Vandana Aggarwal vs. Pranav Goyal*", whereby the learned Family Court Judge dismissed the application filed by the revisionist for restoration of his defence, which was struck off vide order dated 31.01.2025.

2. It is submitted that learned trial Court passed an interim maintenance order, directing the revisionist to pay Rs. 50,000/- per month to the respondent from the date of filing of maintenance petition and such order is



subject matter of challenge before this Court in CRL.REV.P. 753/2024, wherein this Court directed the revisionist to pay 20% of the arrears of the maintenance, within one month from the date of that order, and referred the matter to mediation. He further submits that revisionist has deposited Rs. 7,00,000/- towards maintenance arrears out of total arrears amount of approximately Rs. 23,00,000/-. However, on 31.01.2025, learned trial Court struck off the defence of revisionist on the ground of non-payment of maintenance arrears.

3. Since, CRL.REV.P. 753/2024, challenging the grant of interim maintenance is stated to be pending before the Bench of Hon'ble Ms. Justice Swarana Kanta Sharma, subject to orders passed by Hon'ble Chief Justice, place this matter before the same Bench on 11.11.2025.
