Mr. Khan, counsel for Petitioners, argues that the remarks mentioned against names of Petitioners in the eligibility list dated 29th November, 2024, can prejudice the Petitioners for becoming part of Combined Haj Group Organisers¹. The said remarks are only to the effect that the eligibility of the

Petitioners is subject to the outcome of the present writ petitions pending before this Court. However, Mr. Khan also points out that, in fact, there is no such condition mentioned in the Certificate of Eligibility dated 29th November, 2024, issued to Petitioners.

5. In view of the foregoing, the instant applications are disposed of with a direction that Petitioners shall be at liberty to take recourse to appropriate legal proceedings in the case the remarks against their names, as mentioned the eligibility list, would disentitle them to be part of CHGO or prejudice them in any other manner.

6. All rights and contentions of parties to that extent are reserved.

7. With the above directions, the applications are disposed of.
