1. This hearing has been done through hybrid mode.
2. The present petition under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, seeks the following prayers:

“i. initiate contempt of court proceedings against the contemnor/respondent for deliberately disobeying the Order dated 28.05.2025 in W.P. (C) No. 7086/2025 titled "**Rajender Singh alias Raju & Ors. Vs. The District Magistrate & Ors.**", by this Hon'ble Court and punish them in accordance with law;
ii. direct the contemnor/respondent to pay exemplary costs to the petitioner for being compelled to file the present petition; and
iii. Pass any such other or further order which this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and appropriate in the facts and circumstances of the case and in the interest of justice.”

3. *Vide* order dated 28.05.2025 in W.P.(C) 7086/2025 and connected matters, the learned Single Judge of this Court had passed the following directions:

“3. Learned counsel appearing for GNCTD assures the Court that the implementation of recovery certificate would be carried out



within a period of four weeks and the guidelines in the notification would be adhered to in future as well. The statement made on behalf of State Government is taken on record. In lieu thereof, the cost imposed, if any, is waived.”

4. Issue notice.
5. On the petitioner taking necessary steps, issue notice to the respondents through all permissible modes, including electronic mail, if any, returnable on 02.03.2026.
