1. This application has been filed seeking the following reliefs:

- a) Grant an ad-interim stay restraining Respondent No1 and Respondent No. 3, his agents, representatives and associates from in any manner representing himself as an office bearer of the Petitioner Federation, and from issuing any communication, emails, advisories or directions to players or any third parties in relation to the selection of players or participation in the 20th Asian Games or any other international or national event pertaining to Golf;
- b) Restrain the Respondents from in any manner interfering with or meddling in the selection process of the Petitioner for the Indian Team for Golf for the Asian Games 2026 or any other international sporting event pending disposal of the writ petition;



c) Direct the Respondent No. 1 to accept the teams selected by the Petitioner for the Asian Games 2026 for the sport of Golf and any other multi sporting event like the Olympic Games/ Commonwealth Games in the future in which the team entries are to be sent through the IOA;

2. Replies are yet to be filed on behalf of respondents no.1 and 3.
3. Last opportunity of two (2) weeks is given to respondents no.1 and 3 to file reply.
4. Rejoinder thereto, if any, be filed within one (1) week thereafter.
5. Counsel appearing on behalf of respondent no.1/Indian Olympic Association ('IOA') submits that names received by IOA for formation of the team in the discipline of golf to represent India in the forthcoming Asian Games scheduled in Japan, have been updated on the portal of the Organizing Committee of the Asian Games.
