1. The present writ petition has been filed since it is the case of the petitioner that he is not getting any water supply in his house situated in *Gali No. 9, Sadh Nagar, Palam Colony, New Delhi*.
2. As per the Memo of Parties, the address of the petitioner is as follows:
*C-22/9A, Gali No. 9, Sadh Nagar,
Palam Colony, Near Singhal Hospital,
New Delhi – 110045*
3. Mr. Karunesh Tandon, learned counsel appearing for the Delhi Jal Board (“DJB”), submits that two tube wells have been installed in the area in question and the water is being supplied from the reservoir of the said



tube well to the various households.

4. However, the aforesaid fact is disputed by learned counsel appearing for the petitioner.

5. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner further submits that despite orders passed by this Court, water tanker is not being provided in the area in question.

6. Mr. Indrajeet Prakash, Assistant Engineer (Phone No. 7827896582) from DJB, is present in Court. He reiterates that two tube wells have been installed in the area in question from where water supply is being provided to the various households.

7. Considering the submissions made before this Court, that the petitioner is not receiving any water supply, Mr. Indrajeet Prakash, Assistant Engineer, DJB is directed to visit the house of the petitioner within a period of one week, from today.

8. Before visiting the residence of the petitioner, the concerned official shall intimate learned counsel appearing for the petitioner, on the phone number which is reflected in today's order.

9. During the inspection, the official of the DJB shall assess as to why water supply is not provided to the petitioner's residence and take steps with regard to rectifying any anomaly, if any, with respect thereto.

10. Further, the DJB shall also supply water tanker in the area in question as and when such request is made by the petitioner in this regard.

11. Phone number of the concerned official is reflected in today's order and the petitioner is at liberty to call the said official on the said phone number for purpose of supply of water tanker.

12. Let a Status Report be filed by the Delhi Jal Board, within a period of



four weeks.

13. Re-notify on 28th January, 2026.
