1. The present petition has been filed by the Petitioner under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 528 of BNSS seeking following prayer:-

- (i) Issue a Writ, Order or Direction in the nature of Habeus Corpus directing the Respondents No.1 and 2 to forthwith produce the children namely Master A and Ms. S before this Hon'ble Court;
- (ii) Pass an Order/Writ/Direction declaring the detention of the children by Respondent No. 2 in India illegal and in violation of procedures established by law;
- (iii) Issue an appropriate order1 direction permitting the Petitioner to take the minor children to USA with him.
- (iv) Issue an appropriate order 1 direction directing the Respondent No.2 to handover the custody of the minor children to the Petitioner with their passports and other documents, which are in her custody and possession.
- (v) Pending final disposal of the present writ .petition, pass an order/writ/direction to Respondent No.2 to permit the Petitioner to meet the children in person as well as through video conferencing without any involvement, interference or influence of the Respondent No.2;
