ORDER

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1. Learned counsel appearing for the respondent requests for accommodation stating that the matter is at the stage of consultation with the Additional Solicitor General to decide whether it would be appropriate to file a curative petition before the Supreme Court.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has opposed the adjournment sought by the learned counsel for the respondent.
3. Learned senior counsel for the petitioner has alluded to the order passed by the Central Administrative Tribunal dated 21.02.2017 whereby, in terms of the directions contained in paragraph no.17, the respondent was directed to complete the process of cadre review of the



IAS officers of Arunachal Pradesh-Goa-Mizoram and Union Territory [“AGMUT”] Cadre within a period of six weeks. It appears that the said order was assailed in W.P.(C) 4817/2018 before the Division Bench of this Court *vide* order dated 29.07.2024 dismissed the same.

4. This contempt petition was filed on 18.11.2024 and on that date, it was apprised that an SLP has been preferred before the Supreme Court. Learned counsel for the petitioner has pointed out that the SLP bearing diary no.2812/2025 has since been dismissed by the Supreme Court *vide* order dated 10.02.2025 which is placed on the record.

5. In view of the above, it is manifest that the respondents have deliberately and wilfully not complied with the directions of this Court.

6. Let the respondents appear through VC on 03.04.2025 at 12.30 p.m. and the relevant record be also produced before this Court to show as to what measures have been taken to implement the directions of this Court.

7. It is clarified that the new incumbent officer in terms of CM APPL.12358/2025 be issued notice to appear before this Court through VC.
