1. We are informed by Mr. Ashim Shridhar, learned counsel for respondent no.3/DDA that Mr.Surajit Jaradhara, Director Building (Mobile No.9811267069), has been appointed as Nodal Officer to represent before the Committee.
2. The Delhi Development Authority, New Delhi Municipal Council and the Government of NCT of Delhi shall inform the learned counsel for the Committee of their nodal officers and their full contact details.
3. Ms. Monika Arora has informed this Court that for the Committee, the North Delhi Municipal Corporation has identified the same premises as were made available to the Committee appointed in W.P.(C) 3147/2017 on the 12th Floor of Civic Centre of the Minto Road. All other facilities which were made available to the said Committee shall also be made available on the same terms and conditions as in terms of orders passed in W.P.(C) 3147/2017.
4. The information to this effect shall be communicated within one day from today.
5. We are informed by Mr. Shohit Chaudhry, learned counsel appearing for the Committee that the meeting of the Committee has been scheduled on 6th April, 2018 at 4:00 p.m. for the time being at Chamber No. 422-A, New Lawyers' Chambers, Supreme Court of India, New Delhi. It shall be the responsibility of all authorities to ensure that they are duly represented by

the nodal officers of the Committee.

6. It shall be open for any counsel representing the petitioner also to facilitate the deliberations of the Committee. It shall be open for the Committee to call upon any persons or authorities being effective for consideration of the matter. Inasmuch as the Government of NCT of Delhi would be representing before the Committee, we leave it open to the Committee to call upon the concerned authority from the Department of Revenue, Department of Forests and Director Panchayat as well as from the Office of Inspector General of Registration.

7. So far as W.P.(C) 1807/2018 is concerned, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that even after the cosmetic demolition effected on 14th March, 2018, massive unauthorized construction is going on. The petition contends that the same is part of forest area. Let an Officer of the level of Deputy Commissioner (South-East, Revenue) conduct a physical inspection of the area. A report with photographs of the status of at the time of his visit shall be filed before us before the next date of hearing.

8. The respondents shall file counter affidavits, if any, not already filed before the next date of hearing.
