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1. This hearing has been done through hybrid mode.
2. The present petition under Sections 10, 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India seeks following prayers:-

“a) Summon the Respondent and proceed and punish him in accordance with the provision of the Contempt of Courts Act.

b) Issue direction to the Respondent to immediately comply with the orders of this Hon'ble Court. dated 19/09/2024 in LPA No. 941 of 2024

AND/OR

c) Pass any such other and further orders which this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case.”

3. *Vide* judgment dated 19.09.2024, the learned Division Bench of this Court passed the following directions:-

“29. However, the learned Tribunal has awarded respondent's reinstatement with full back wages, which cannot be permitted based upon the principle of 'no work no pay'. We hereby modify the order passed by the Tribunal, which is upheld by the learned Single Judge,



to the extent and hold that the respondent shall be entitled to 50% back wages for the period he has not performed his duties.”

4. Issue notice.
5. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent accepts notice.
6. Let a compliance report be filed before the next date of hearing.
