ORDER

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1. Mr. Vishwendra Verma, learned counsel for respondent Nos.4, 5 and 6 submits that though the present petition is not maintainable, as per the instructions, respondent No.4 (father of the child) is very much interested in finding amicable solution of the matter. It is also submitted by Mr. Verma that the child is hesitant and reluctant in going back to his mother but he would have no objection if during mediation, Mediation Cell also takes help of a child-counselor.

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2. Sh. Vikram Panwar, learned counsel for the petitioner though submits that the petition is very much maintainable, in the interest of justice, he also has no objection if the matter is referred for mediation.
3. In view of the above, the matter is referred to *Delhi High Court Mediation & Conciliation Centre* as per following terms:-
 - (i) Both the parties shall report to Delhi High Court Mediation & Conciliation Centre on 04.11.2025 at 4:00 pm.
 - (ii) Learned Organizing Secretary, Delhi High Court Mediation & Conciliation Centre is requested to appoint a Senior Mediator, preferably, Sh. J.P. Sengh (subject to his availability) with further request to make best efforts to conclude mediation proceedings within two weeks.
 - (iii) Such mediation be held at least twice a week and on mediation dates, respondent No.4 shall also bring his son to the Mediation Centre so that on such dates, not only the child counselor has interaction with the child as well as the parents, the petitioner is also in a position to meet her son in the Children Room for around two hours.
4. The child-counselor shall send her report in a sealed cover to this Court by next date of hearing.
5. Let the outcome be awaited for 24.11.2025.
