1. This application has been filed by the petitioner praying for the following reliefs:

“a. Modify the earlier order/directions and permit the Petitioner- Mother to pick up the minor child at 9:00 a.m. and return him by 2:00 p.m. during the period of access, keeping in view the had tender age of the child, his proneness to sickness and the prevailing hot weather conditions;

b. pass any other order(s) as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the interest of justice.”



2. This Court, *vide* its order dated 09th January, 2026, while disposing of the petition on the basis of the consent terms, had already clarified that the said consent terms shall continue for a further period of 02 months or until further orders are passed by the competent Court, and that the petitioner can avail of the remedies as may be available to her in accordance with law in that regard, within a period of 02 months from the date of the order.

3. Any modification required in the consent terms, therefore, has to be prayed before the competent Court in appropriate proceedings. The present application is not maintainable for the same and is accordingly dismissed, leaving it open to the petitioner to avail of the remedies in appropriate proceedings and in accordance with law.
