1. Previously on 08th January 2025, the Court had disposed of the petition based on an assurance given by respondent that the representation shall be decided within a period of four weeks.
2. This application has been filed, seeking revival of the contempt proceedings.
3. The hearing has been granted yesterday by DDA, as informed by Ms. Manika Tripathy, counsel for DDA.
4. Counsel for petitioner states that a mere cursory hearing was given,



just to show compliance to this Court, of the previous order.

5. Considering that the assurance was given on 08th January 2025, and hearing has been given now, on 26th March 2025, more than three months later, accordingly, this Court is inclined to direct DDA to provide a proper hearing to petitioner within a period of 1 week in compliance with order of 01st March 2024, and then decide their representation within the period of three weeks thereafter.

6. The hearing will be held on 03rd April 2025, a decision will be passed within the three weeks thereafter.
