1. Allowed, subject to all just exceptions.

2. Application stands disposed of.

3. The present appeal is directed against the Judgment dated 01.09.2025 and the Order on Sentence dated 27.09.2025 passed by the Ld. ASJ-05, East District, Karkardooma Courts, Delhi in SC No. 1528/2019 by which the Appellants have been convicted in FIR No. 22/2019, registered at Police Station Kalyan Puri for the offence punishable under Sections 302/201/34 of IPC.

4. By the Order on Sentence dated 27.09.2025, the Appellants have been sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for life and with fine of Rs.18,000/- each for the offence committed under Section 302 of IPC and rigorous imprisonment for a period of three years along with fine of Rs.2,000/- each for the offence committed under Section 201 of IPC. In default of payment of fine, the Appellants shall further undergo simple imprisonment for a period of three months.



5. It is the case of the Appellants that there was a cross case, wherein another FIR No. 23/2019 arising out of the same incident has been registered for offence under Section 308/34 IPC and that the learned Trial Court has not appreciated the facts in the correct perspective.

6. Admit.

7. Let the digital copy of the Trial Court Record be requisitioned.

8. The Registry is directed to supply an e-copy of the paper book along with the Trial Court Record (TCR) to the learned Counsel for the Appellant as well as the learned APP for the Respondent/State. The Registry is directed to ensure that the paper book and the TCR are properly bookmarked before supplying the e-copies to the Counsels.

9. List in due course.
