I.A. 26511/2025 (O-XI R-1(4) of the Commercial Courts Act)

1. The present application has been filed on behalf of the plaintiff seeking leave to file additional documents under the Commercial Courts Act, 2015.
2. The plaintiff is permitted to file additional documents in accordance with the provisions of the Commercial Courts Act, 2015 and the Delhi High Court (Original Side) Rules, 2018.
3. Accordingly, the application is disposed of.

I.A. 26512/2025 (O-XI R-1(6) of the Commercial Courts Act)

10. Issue Notice.
11. Reply be filed within four weeks.
12. Rejoinder thereto, if any, be filed within two weeks thereafter.
13. List on 9th March, 2026.

I.A. 26514/2025 (seeking condonation of delay in re-filing the plaint)

14. This application has been filed by the plaintiff seeking condonation of delay of 64 days in re-filing the present plaint after curing defects.
15. For the reasons stated in the application, the delay in re-filing the present suit is condoned.
16. Application stands disposed of accordingly.

17. Let the plaint be registered as a suit.
18. Issue summons.
19. Summons be issued to the defendants through all modes. The summons shall state that the written statement(s) shall be filed by the defendants within thirty days from the date of the receipt of summons. Along with the written statement(s), the defendants shall also file affidavit



of admission/denial of the documents of the plaintiff, without which the written statement(s) shall not be taken on record.

20. Liberty is given to the plaintiff to file replications, if any, within thirty days from the receipt of the written statement(s). Along with the replications filed by the plaintiff, affidavit of admission/denial of the documents of the defendants be filed by the plaintiff.

21. The parties shall file all original documents in support of their respective claims along with their respective pleadings. In case parties are placing reliance on a document, which is not in their power and possession, its detail and source shall be mentioned in the list of reliance, which shall also be filed with the pleadings.

22. If any of the parties wish to seek inspection of any documents, the same shall be sought and given within the timelines.

23. List before the Joint Registrar on 15th December, 2025 for completion of service and pleadings.

24. List before the Court on 9th March, 2026.
