1. Allowed, subject to all just exceptions.
2. Application stands disposed of.

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3. The plaint be registered as a suit.
4. Issue summons. The learned counsel appearing on advance service accepts summons on behalf of the defendant nos.1 to 3 and waives the formal service of summons.



5. He submits that complete copy of the paper book including plaint, applications and the documents have been received by him. Let defendant nos. 1 to 3 file written statement within thirty days.
 6. On plaintiff taking steps, summons be issued to the defendant no.4 by all permissible modes. The summons shall indicate that written statement must be filed within thirty days from the date of receipt of summons.
 7. The defendants shall also file an affidavit of admission/denial of the documents filed by the plaintiff, failing which the written statement shall not be taken on record.
 8. The plaintiff is at liberty to file replication thereto within thirty days after filing of the written statement. The replication shall be accompanied by affidavit of admission/denial in respect of the documents filed by the defendant, failing which the replication shall not be taken on record.
 9. It is made clear that any unjustified denial of documents may lead to an order of costs against the concerned party.
 10. Any party seeking inspection of documents may do so in accordance with the Delhi High Court (Original Side) Rules, 2018.
 11. List before the learned Joint Registrar for completion of service, pleadings, admission/denial of documents and marking of exhibits on 14.02.2025.
 12. List before Court on 25.03.2025.

13. Issue notice. The learned counsel named above accepts notice on behalf of the defendant nos. 1 to 3.
