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1. The grievance articulated in the present petition is with regard to the downgrading of the petitioner from B.Tech (Electronics and Communication Engineering) to B.Tech (Electrical Engineering).
2. The learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner has invited attention of the Court to Annexure P-13 to contend that initially the petitioner was allotted a seat in B.Tech (Electrical Engineering in the third round), however, the petitioner did not accept and decided to go for upgradation. Accordingly, the petitioner was upgraded and was allotted a seat in B.Tech (Electronics and Communication Engineering) during the fourth round.
3. He submits that the list at page 85 of the petition shows that the petitioner's name finds mentioned in the list of students in ECE-A (First



Year) at serial no. 18.

4. He submits that the petitioner also attended the classes of B.Tech (Electronics and Communication Engineering) from 01.08.2024 to 09.09.2024.

5. It is further the contention of the petitioner that the petitioner had also availed the upgradation for B.Tech (Computer Science and Engineering), which was also allotted but the case of the respondent University is that the same allocation was not accepted by the petitioner, therefore, he was not allotted a seat in B.Tech (Computer Science and Engineering).

6. Further, contention of the learned counsel for the petitioner is that in case the allocation of a seat in B.Tech (Computer Science and Engineering) was not approved and accepted, the petitioner ought to have been allowed to continue in B.Tech (Electronics and Communication Engineering) whereas, the respondents without any justification has downgraded the petitioner to his first allotment i.e. B.Tech (Electrical Engineering).

7. Mr. Mohinder J.S. Rupal, learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent no.2/University of Delhi prays for time to seek instructions.

8. Let needful be done before the next date.

9. Re-notify on 04.08.2025 in the first 05 matters.
