2. The petitioner has assailed Labour Court Award directing reinstatement of the respondent workman with full back wages. Learned counsel for petitioner submits that the respondent was only part time accountant, employed with few other companies also during the period from mid 2005 to 2018. But in that regard, *prima facie* there is no cogent document on record. As regards the respondent's working status, learned counsel for petitioner seeks to place reliance on only one sentence in the cross examination of the respondent, which also is only a suggestion.

3. Subject to the petitioner depositing the 50% of the amount under



execution with the Registry of this Court within four weeks, to be followed by deposit of the remaining 50% within next four weeks, operation of the impugned award shall remain stayed till next date. However it is made clear that if the said amount is not deposited within the said period, there shall be no protection and the respondent shall be at liberty to seek execution of the impugned award in accordance with law.

4. Subject to petitioner taking steps within one week, notice through all modes be issued to the respondent returnable on 17.04.2025 before Registrar.
