1. The petitioner has filed this application seeking exemption from depositing the second instalment of the amount under execution. The application has been filed in furtherance of circumstances described in last order. Learned counsel for petitioner submits that no prejudice would be caused to respondent if the application is allowed since the matter is listed in the month of April, 2025. I do not agree with this submission. The entire purpose of last order was to secure the awarded amount and it was made clear that if the said amount is not deposited, the respondent would be at liberty to seek execution.

2. After addressing partly, learned counsel for petitioner seeks permission to withdraw this application on instructions of his client. But learned counsel fervently pleads for extension of time to comply with last



order. Accordingly, the application is dismissed as withdrawn. However, the petitioner is granted another four weeks from today to deposit the balance amount of the awarded amount. It is again made clear that if within four weeks, the balance amount is not deposited, respondent shall be at liberty to seek execution of the impugned award.

3. Learned counsel for petitioner seeks liberty to file fresh application for permission to file additional documents. This case was set up in the present application, though it was not required if the petitioner wanted only extension of time. The petitioner may move the application, if so advised.
