2. The petitioners have assailed the award dated 06.05.2023, directing the present respondent to be paid pay scales at par with nurses as per 6th CPC with effect from 01.01.2006 in addition to certain allowances.

3. Learned counsel for respondent appearing on advance intimation points out that the copy of award filed with the petition is not a complete one since subsequent to passing of the award, a modification in the same was carried out by the learned Tribunal vide order dated 21.08.2023. Learned



counsel for petitioners submits that he obtained certified copies of the entire trial court record in September 2024, but the same does not contain any such modification. Therefore, digitized record of the learned Industrial Tribunal be requisitioned within one week.

4. Further, as pointed out by learned counsel for respondent, there is also an unexplained delay of more than 500 days in filing the present petition, for which there is no condonation application.
5. As such, presently notice of the petition is not being issued.
