1. This hearing has been done through hybrid mode.

CM APPL. 68146/2025 (Exemption)

2. Allowed, subject to all just exceptions. The application is disposed of.
CONT.CAS(C) 1627/2025 & CM APPL. 68147/2025 (condonation of delay 95 days)

3. The present petition under Sections 2(c), 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 seeks the following prayers:

“a. proceed against the Respondent herein as per the provisions of section 2 (c), 10 and 12 of Contempt of Court Act and further pleads to try prosecute and punish and sentence the respondent as per the letter & spirit of the aforesaid provision.

b. direct the Respondent to comply with the order dated 06.05.2024 passed by Hon'ble Division Bench in case WP (C) No.4012/2022 titled as Smt. Pushpa V/s Govt, of NCT of Delhi & Ors. with immediate effect.

c. Any other relief which this Hon'ble Court deem fit and proper under the facts and circumstances of the case may kindly be passed in favour of the Petitioner and against contemnors / Respondent.”



4. *Vide* order dated 06.05.2024 in W.P.(C) 4012/2022, the learned Division Bench of this Court passed the following directions:

“2. Mr. Pathak, learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent no.1 (LAC), on instructions submits that the reference under Section 18 of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 shall be made, subject to verification, within eight weeks from date.

3. In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed in this petition.”

5. Issue notice.

6. On the petitioner taking necessary steps, issue notice to the respondents through all permissible modes, including electronic mail, if any, returnable on 03.03.2026.
