5. The instant writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 has been filed on behalf of the petitioners for the following reliefs:

*“A. Pass a writ of mandamus thereby directing the respondent no. 01 to take necessary steps with USA to expedite the extradition proceedings of Sh. Amit Wadhwa forthwith, and,
B. Pass a writ of mandamus thereby directing the Ld. Trial Court- ACMM-01, District Central, Tis Hazari Courts, Delhi to conduct trial of Cr. Case 300096/2016 titled as State Versus Surinder Wadhwa & others on day to day basis in the facts & circumstances of the present case, or;
C. In alternative to Prayer (B), Pass a writ of mandamus thereby directing the Ld. Trial Court- ACMM-01, District Central, Tis Hazari Courts, Delhi to expedite the proceedings of Cr. Case 300096/2016 titled as State Versus Surinder Wadhwa & ors, and;
D. Any other order/relief which this Hon'ble Court deem fit to pass/grant in the facts of the present case.”*

6. Heard.

7. Issue notice. Notice is accepted by learned CGSC for the respondent No.1 as well as by learned Additional Standing Counsel for the State on behalf of respondent No.2/Delhi Police and they seek three weeks' time to file the status report. Let needful be done within the time as prayed for.
