1. Respondent No. 2 has filed a status report dated 30.01.2025. The status report gives an update of the extradition proceedings of the accused Mr. Amit Wadhwa, which is outdated and last reference is to the year 2018. The status report fails to give any details of the further steps taken by the prosecution between 2018 and 2025.
2. Respondent No. 1 is directed to file its status report one (1) week prior to the next date of hearing with respect to the current status of the extradition proceedings of Mr. Amit Wadhwa.
3. Ld. ASC states on instructions from the Investigating Officer ('IO') that Look Out Circular ('LOC') issued against Mr. Amit Wadhwa is valid



and subsisting.

4. He states that Red Corner Notice issued against Mr. Amit Wadhwa, which is valid till 09.01.2029. In this regard, he has referred to a letter dated 24.07.2024 issued by National Central Bureau ('NCB').

5. In response, learned counsel for the Petitioner states that however, on a perusal of the official website of the Interpol, the details of the said Red Corner Notice are not available.

6. The NCB is directed to ensure that appropriate steps are taken to ensure that the Red Corner Notice is updated on the website of the Interpol.

7. The IO shall write to the concerned officer of NCB with an order of this Court, to take steps to ensure that the website of the Interpol is updated.

8. The Petitioner has raised a grievance that though the FIR is for the year 2009, the charges in the matter have still not been framed.

9. The Trial Court is requested to send the progress report to this Court before the next date of hearing.
