“a) Call for the records of Ct. Case No. 94 of 2020 titled as Mohar Singh Vs. Babu Lal Baisla & Anr. from the court of Sh. Navjeet Budhiraja, ASJ-02, (South), Saket Court, New Delhi.

b) Revise and set aside the order dated 02.07.2024 passed by the Ld. Court of Sh. Navjeet Budhiraja, ASJ-02, (South), Saket Court, New Delhi, in the matter of Mohar Singh Vs. Babu Lal Baisla in Ct. Case No. 94 of 2020 and restore the Complaint to its original number and direct the Ld. Trial Court to conduct the trial of the present case and decide the case on merit.

c) Based on pre-summoning evidences, issue summons/process to the Respondents for committing of offences U/s-3(1)(r)(s) R/w Section 3(2)(v)(va) R/w Section 4 of the SC&ST Act R/w 506 (Part –II)/190/166 IPC and direct them to face the trial.

d) pass such further Order(s) as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit in the facts and circumstances of the case.”
