ORDER

1. The present writ petition has been filed seeking directions to the respondent no.1/BSES, not to encroach upon the pavement (footpath) meant for the general public, by installing the transformer at *Shiv Mandir Road, Opposite Arihant Nagar, Jain Colony, Madipur, New Delhi*.
2. In the order passed by this Court on 6th November, 2025, submissions on behalf of the respondent no.2/MCD were noted that since the concerned road falls within the jurisdiction of the Public Works Department (PWD), PWD would be the necessary party to the present writ petition. Accordingly, PWD was impleaded as a respondent.



3. In view of the aforesaid, the respondent no.2/MCD is not a necessary party in the present writ petition and is deleted from the array of parties.
4. Amended memo of parties be filed within one (1) week.
5. Counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent no.3/PWD and the respondent no.1/BSES seek time to file counter-affidavit.
6. Let a complete set of petition be supplied to counsel for the respondent no.3/PWD, who shall file counter-affidavit within six (6) weeks.
7. Last opportunity is given to the respondent no.1/BSES to file counter affidavit, failing which the right to file counter-affidavit shall automatically stand closed.
8. List on 30th September, 2026.
