1. Petitioner/Judgment Debtor has challenged order dated 01.11.2025 of the Execution Court, whereby the warrants of attachment of moveable assets were issued. It is submitted by learned counsel for petitioner/Judgment Debtor that the attachment warrants have been issued without disposing of the objections filed by the petitioner/Judgment Debtor. It is submitted by learned counsel for petitioner/Judgment Debtor that one of the objections was pendency of SLP, but that SLP was dismissed *in limine* on 03.11.2025. But in addition to that also, the petitioner took certain objections. It is contended by learned counsel for petitioner/Judgment Debtor that without disposing of those objections, attachment warrants ought not to have been issued.

2. I have not tested the merits of those objections. But *prima facie*, I am in agreement with learned counsel for petitioner/Judgment Debtor that



without disposing of the objections, attachment warrants ought not to have been issued.

3. Considering the circumstances, operation of the impugned order is stayed till next date and the learned Execution Court is directed to dispose of the objections on merits by the next date, so that there is no undue delay in disposal of the execution proceedings. For compliance, copy of this order be sent to the learned Execution Court forthwith.

4. Subject to petitioner/Judgment Debtor taking steps within one week, notice through all modes be issued to the respondent, returnable on 18.03.2026 before Registrar.
